Students must take two courses from the same cluster, with two different course prefixes in order to fulfill the requirement. Also, note that these are "expected" not guaranteed offerings and that some courses might be cancelled. If you notice any errors or omissions from this list, please let us know.

Students who plan to complete one Themes requirement through an approved study abroad program can elect to take <u>ANY</u> other approved Themes course to complete the Themes requirement.
