

Expected Themes Course Offerings, 2018-2019 (Rev. 3/5/18)

Below you will find a listing of Themes courses expected to be offered in 2018-2019. Please note that some courses have prerequisites (not listed) which are determined by departments. Students are not exempt from a prerequisite because they are enrolling in the course to fulfill the Themes requirement. Only the department chair and/or the course instructor may waive any departmentally established prerequisite.

Students may only earn Theme credit if they have junior standing (60 earned credit hours) or have completed all four Foundations courses or have completed the WOC Portfolio. Students must take two courses from the same cluster, with two different course prefixes (e.g, ENG, MCH). Also, only one Themes course can count towards a student's major or minor. Finally, students who earn Themes credit through **approved study abroad** can elect to take **any** other Themes course to complete the requirement.

Students should choose Themes courses wisely--**avoid clusters with limited courses offerings is possible**. Students who encounter difficulty completing a cluster requirement due to limited course offerings should contact the IC Director (icore@mountunion.edu | KHIC 233) about finding a suitable replacement course.
