

Caution – Poison Ivy



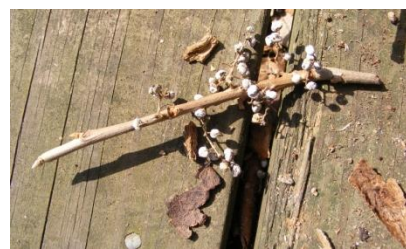
Poison ivy has three leaflets. "Leaflets three, let it be."

In the spring, poison ivy is often red and shiny, but it soon turns green.



The bud resembles a cat's claw.



The oil is present at all times of the year.

The leaflets often separate when they fall.
